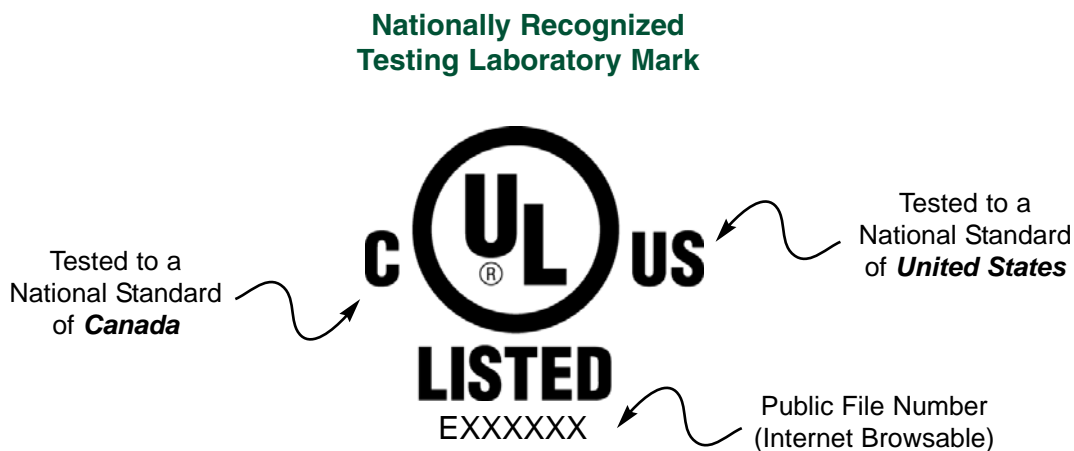

How to Read a NRTL Marking

Our operators and panels are tested by independent **Nationally Recognized Testing Laboratories (NRTL)**, such as **UL** and **CSA**. You can find variations of the markings below on our products. They are easy to interpret, here's how...



Possible Markings



If a product carries any of these markings, it means:

- 1) That the NRTL has tested representative samples of the product and determined that it meets given requirements. These requirements are voluntary, consensus-based nationally recognized standards, ex: ANSI/UL325:2010 and CAN/CSA 22.2/247.
- 2) That the NRTL performs regular surprise inspections of the manufacturing facilities in order to verify the conformity of the processes and products to the standard(s).
