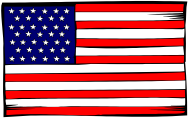
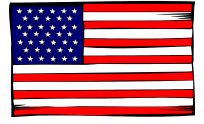

Manaras-Opera is Ready for UL325 2010 Compliance



On August 29, 2010 UL325 is Being Revised. Manaras-Opera Will Comply to the Revised Standard.

- The ANSI/UL325 voluntary standard is a National standard in the United States.
- The revised requirement is: commercial/industrial operators must monitor a primary external entrapment protection device (photo cells, sensing edge) or must operate in constant-pressure-to-close.
- Secondary non-monitored protection devices (such as a pneumatic sensing edge) are permissible.
- To bear an agency marking, the operator plus the monitored primary entrapment protection device will be tested by a Nationally Recognized Testing Laboratory (such as UL or CSA). Manaras-Opera has selected to work with Underwriters Laboratories Inc. (UL).
- The ANSI/UL325 standard, as with any standard, is not a law. Compliance to the ANSI/UL325 standard is voluntary.
- CDO's manufactured prior to August 29, 2010, can still be sold, installed and repaired after the revised ANSI/UL325 voluntary standard takes effect. ANSI/UL325 is a design/manufacturing standard. It is not an installation standard.
- Manaras-Opera will be offering ANSI/UL325 compliant operators with monitored primary external entrapment protection devices, as of August 29, 2010.
